



# NORTH COUNTY CHARTER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

## Extended Day Program Information

**Purpose:** The North County Charter School Extended Day Program provides services for families who need child care before and after school. It is designed to enrich children's lives educationally, socially, emotionally, and physically in a safe and familiar setting.

**Who May Attend:** All NCCS children in grades K - 5 may attend.

**Activities:** A variety of enrichment activities including homework assistance, arts and crafts, computers, music, games, and outdoor activities is offered. Nutritious snacks are also served during the program.

**Program Hours:** The program is open on regular school days.  
Morning Hours: 7:00 a.m. – 8:20 a.m.  
Afternoon Hours: From the end of the school day until 6:00 p.m.

**Cost:** Fees are due each Monday of the week or the first day of the school week. If a child does not attend at all for an entire week, the family will not be billed.

**Afternoon fees 4-5 days:**

\$25 a week for first child  
\$20 a week for each additional child

**1-3-Day fee:**

\$15 a week (any 3 days)  
\$10 a week for each additional child

**Morning fee:**

\$10 a week per child  
\$5 a week for each additional child

**Overtime Charge:**

\$10 per child for every 15 minute increment.

**Late Fee**

If payment is not paid on the first day of the week, a \$10.00 late fee per child will be assessed.

**Registration:** Registration forms must be completed and a \$10.00 registration fee paid before a child may participate in the program. Medical, emergency contact, and special needs information are required.

**Payment of Fees:** Weekly fees must be paid on Monday or the first school day of the week. Payments may be by check unless a check has been returned for insufficient funds. In such cases, all future payments must be in cash or money order. Participation in the program will be denied for lack of payment until all payments are made.

**Sign-Out:** In the interest of safety, the parent or guardian is expected to sign his child out of the Extended Day Program each day. NO child will be released to a person not authorized in writing by the custodial parent on file with the program. Persons not recognized by the staff will be asked to show identification.

**Discipline:** In the interest of safety, students will abide by the North County Charter School Code of Conduct and the guidelines set forth for appropriate behavior.
