

You have the right to ask for the following information about each of your child's teachers and instructional assistants/paraprofessionals:

1. The teacher's Florida certification area(s) and,
 - a. If the teacher is teaching infield, or
 - b. If the teacher is qualified infield according to NCCS board policies.
2. The teacher's college degree(s) and areas of study.
3. The teacher's advanced college degree(s) and areas of study.
4. The qualifications of any instructional assistant/paraprofessionals who provide services to your child.

In addition, you have the right to be provided information on your student's level of achievement on assessments like the FAST test, STAR test, or NWEA in Reading, Mathematics, and Science. This information will be available from your child's teacher and on the FOCUS Parent Portal.
